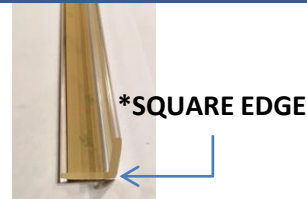
PROTECTIVE GUARDS SERVE TWO PURPOSES:

- 1. PROTECTS OR SHIELDS FINGERS FROM ROTARY CUTTERS**
- 2. SERVES AS A PICKER-UPPER! PICK UP YOUR RULER EASILY!**

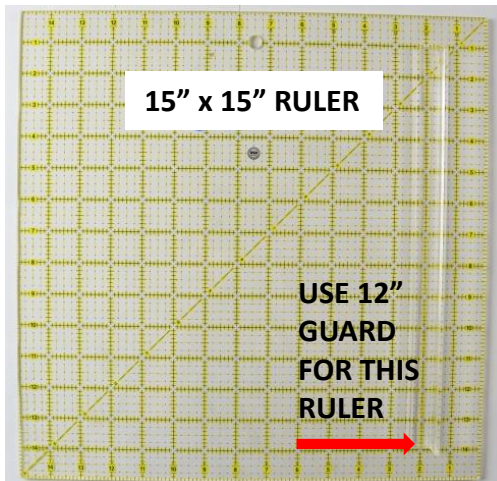

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLACING PROTECTIVE GUARD ON RULERS:

1. Practice placement before peeling the paper backing from the adhesive strip
2. Place the guard so that the lip or the edge with the adhesive is facing towards the 6" line.
3. Place the square edge* of the guard vertically at the 2 ¼" to 2 3/8" measurement, but not on the 2 ½" measurement. The 2 ½" measurement is one of the most common measurements that you will be cutting and you want to make sure you can see that measurement clearly.
4. Center the guard vertically so that there is approximately one to two inches at the top and bottom of the guard to the top and bottom of the ruler. I call this the "wriggle room"; I have found that if you put the top or bottom of the guard flush with the edge of the ruler, your rotary cutter may "tangle up" with it! (WHICH YOU DO NOT WANT!)
5. Once you feel comfortable with where you are going to place the guard, peel the paper backing off the adhesive and press the guard down on your ruler. Do not move it once you have pressed it down (if at all possible).
6. Let it sit overnight without picking up the ruler by the guard. Next morning, **USE AWAY!**
